

INTERNATIONAL NEEDLECRAFT COMPETITION

1. A piece of needlecraft (any technique) depicting Country of Study.
2. Exhibit must be the work of a financial CWA member. Entry form (**I 1-15**) must be attached. Entries received without the **I 1-15** form will be disqualified.
3. One entry per Group. Group International Officers to arrange judging of Branch entries by a qualified Judge (usually a Handicraft Judge).
4. Exhibit must be recognisable as depicting the Country of Study - **Pictorial or written reference must accompany the exhibit.**
5. Maximum size, including frame, is 30 cm x 30 cm. (A frame is not necessary).
6. Winning Group entries to be delivered in a clearly labelled box to the International Display at State Conference on the Sunday morning immediately prior to Conference. Actual delivery times and location will be advised to Group International Officers once the Conference schedule and location have been confirmed. Entries will be judged at State Conference.
7. First, second and third place winners to be announced during the State International Meeting at State Conference. Prizes: 1st \$50; 2nd \$30; 3rd \$20.
8. All Group winners to be displayed at State Conference.
9. Group International Officers to arrange for collection of entries at State Conference. Entries to be signed for when picked up.
10. Needlecraft to be marked as: Authenticity 50 marks and Workmanship 50 marks.

INTERNATIONAL HANDICRAFT COMPETITION

1. A piece of handicraft traditionally found in the Country of Study. Each Nation has a traditional craft i.e. weaving, felting, different art styles, card and paper making. This will encourage more crafty members to have a go and learn a craft from the Country of Study. Guidelines for local handicraft will be advertised when the Country of Study is announced.
2. Exhibit must be the work of a financial CWA member. Entry form (**I 1-15**) must be attached. Entries received without the **I 1-15** form will be disqualified.
3. One entry per Group. Group International Officers to arrange judging of Branch entries by a qualified Judge (usually a Handicraft Judge).
4. Maximum size, including frame, is 30 cm x 30 cm. (A frame is not necessary.)
5. Winning Group entries to be delivered in a clearly labelled box to the International Display at State Conference on the Sunday morning immediately prior to Conference. Actual delivery times and location will be advised to Group International Officers once the Conference schedule and location have been confirmed. Entries will be judged at State Conference.
6. First, second and third place winners to be announced during the State International Meeting at State Conference. Prizes: 1st \$50; 2nd \$30; 3rd \$20.
7. All Group winners to be displayed at State Conference.
8. Group International Officers to arrange for collection of entries at State Conference. Entries to be signed for when picked up.
9. Handicraft to be marked as follows: Authenticity 50 marks and Workmanship 50 marks.
