

## INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL JOURNAL COMPETITION

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - No entry fee.

- Scope: A factual or imaginative travel journal of a week's holiday in the Country of Study, sharing your experiences with the local people.
- Travel journal may be compiled by a member or members and done collectively or individually.
- To be submitted in a standard 48 page exercise book – not all pages need to be filled.
- The book is a scrapbook of your factual or imaginative visit to the Country of Study. Newsprint, typing, handwriting, drawings and all forms of pictorial representation using any medium can be used.
- The book will be judged on content and presentation. Try and incorporate a wide range of information on your country in a narrative style as if you are there visiting the sites, sampling the foods, experiencing the people and their culture.
- Group International Officers to arrange the judging of Branch travel journals.
- The Group's winning travel journal to be mailed in a clearly labelled envelope with entry form (**I 1-15**) to the State International Officer's home no later than **1 February**. Entries received without the **I 1-15 form** will be disqualified.
- First, second and third prize winners will be announced at the State International meeting during State Conference.
- All Group journals will be displayed at State Conference.
- Group International Officers to arrange collection of journals at Conference. Journals to be signed for when picked up.
- First place (\$100), second place (\$75) and third place (\$50) winners will be announced during the State International meeting at State Conference.

### GENERAL GUIDELINES AND JUDGING CRITERIA

Write Branch and Group name on the last page or inside the back cover.

Travel journal will be judged on authenticity and creativity of tour, presentation and writing style to share information of the country and its people.
